



High School Group Service Programs Code of Conduct

I understand that this Code of Conduct reflects the non-negotiable rules that apply for the duration of the AJWS Group Service Program. Non-compliance of these rules can and will result in dismissal from the program. This Code of Conduct is designed for the benefit and safety of the group and its individual participants. **By signing the enclosed *Agreement and Release by Participant and Parent* you agree to observe this Code of Conduct in its entirety.**

1. I will comply at all times with the program itinerary and the instructions of my AJWS group leaders. I will not leave the group unless I am accompanied by one of the group's staff members.
2. I will act in a safe and responsible manner and will be careful not to endanger the health and safety of others or myself.
3. I will not handle firearms or any other weapons, including machetes.
4. I will not jump, dive or swim in any body of water without explicit permission from the group's leaders.
5. I will not use or possess any drugs that are illegal under the laws of the United States.
6. I will refrain from any behavior that is not legal for someone of my age in the United States including: smoking tobacco and drinking alcohol.
7. I will give all of my prescription medication(s) to the group's leaders, who will administer them according to my doctor's instructions. I will also inform the group's leaders before I take any over-the-counter medications.
8. I will act with integrity and respect for the host community, my fellow volunteers, and AJWS. If I have any questions as to what is within the realm of appropriate behavior, I will speak to the AJWS staff members leading the group.
9. I will refrain from engaging in any romantic relationships and sexual activity for the duration of the program.
